2. The AGM will be held in Tebay Sports & Social Club on Saturday 5th March at 7.00pm for all permit holders and members. There will however be no food served this year because of Covid. There will be a raffle but no auction.
3. Any permit holder may request for a topic to be discussed at the AGM. However, only full members may vote at the AGM. Please submit any item for inclusion in the agenda in writing by email preferably to **The Secretary** by no later than the end of February.
4. 2021 was a poor year with very little water in the river for much of the season. There were 27 nil returns. 11 members reported 62 brown trout, mainly in May; 10 sea trout and 8 salmon up to 12lb(from 2 members). This is less than 50% of all club members. **Please remember that the Committee has authorised that a fine can be levied for failure to submit a catch return, payable before the issue of your next permit;** nil returns by text continue to be acceptable.
5. Permit issues fell again in 2021. We had 78 members and permit holders plus 7 juniors.
6. Please encourage friends and relations to join us as we presently have no waiting list for 2022.
7. Day/Week Tickets are available (1st April – 30th September) which can also be used to introduce your friends to our waters.
8. Please look at our updated website for lots of details on the Club, including Fee payment and a gallery of pictures of our river.
9. **I would be most grateful for your email address if you have one.** Postage charges are a significant cost, and as all news is available on the website www.tebayanglers.com we need to consider future costs.
