1. The Club has held fees at the 2008 level for another year and will not be proposing any change for 2023. Remember that annual fees are due by **1<sup>st</sup> April**. Cheque payments should be sent to: "THE TREASURER, TEBAY ANGLERS, CHAPEL HOUSE, GREENHOLME, PENRITH, CUMBRIA, CA10 3TA". **There are no permit fees for anyone aged 16 and below, but ages 12-16 must carry an EA licence (free) and a TA permit.**

2. The AGM will be held in Tebay Sports & Social Club on **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> March** at 7.00pm for all permit holders and members. Please let us know if you are coming to help with catering arrangements – text Secretary (07840 225098). There will be a free buffet, a raffle and an auction. Donations for the raffle and auction are welcome.
3. Any permit holder may request for a topic to be discussed at the AGM. However, only full members may vote at the AGM. Please submit any item for inclusion in the agenda in writing by email preferably to **The Secretary** by no later than the end of February.
4. 2022 was a mixed year with very little water in the river for much of the early season before increased rainfall in the autumn. There were 26 nil returns. 27 members reported 119 brown trout; 54 sea trout and 13 salmon, mainly small up to 8lb(from 6 members). Thank you for all the returns, an improvement on last year but still not all members. **Please remember that the Committee has authorised that a fine can be levied for failure to submit a catch return, payable before the issue of your next permit;** nil returns by text continue to be acceptable.
5. Permit issues fell a little in 2022. We had 75 members and permit holders including 7 juniors. Our downward trend of members continues.
6. Please encourage friends and relations to join as we presently have no waiting list for 2023.
7. Day/Week Tickets are available (1st April – 30<sup>th</sup> September) which can also be used to introduce your friends to our waters. These are available at Orton and Tebay Post Office but also via text virtual tickets via the Treasurer – see website.
