1. The Club has held fees at the 2008 level for another year and will not be proposing any change for 2025. Remember that annual fees are due by **1st April**. Because of bank charges, payment by bank transfer is recommended - See account details on the website www.tebayanglers.com or contact Audrey Gray (0788 9093848 or agray294@hotmail.com). Cheque payments should be sent to: "THE TREASURER, TEBAY ANGLERS, CHAPEL HOUSE, GREENHOLME, PENRITH, CUMBRIA, CA10 3TA". **There are no permit fees for anyone aged 16 and below, but ages 12-16 must carry an EA licence (free) and a TA permit.**
2. The AGM will be held in Tebay Sports & Social Club on **Saturday 1st March** at 7.00pm for all permit holders and members. Please let us know if you are coming to help with catering arrangements – text Secretary (07840 225098). There will be a free buffet, a raffle and an auction. Donations for the raffle and auction are welcome.
3. Any permit holder may request for a topic to be discussed at the AGM. However, only full members may vote at the AGM. Please submit any item for inclusion in the agenda in writing, by email preferably, to **The Secretary** by no later than the end of January.
4. 2024 was a mixed year with very little water in the river for much of the early season before increased rainfall in the summer and autumn. There were 27 nil returns. 25 members reported 233 brown trout(similar to last year); 55 sea trout(slightly down from last year but similar to 22) and a very encouraging 47 salmon(up from 14). Salmon mainly small up to 8lb but a few at 10,11 and 13lb . Thank you for all the returns but still not all members. Please remember that the Committee has authorised that a fine can be levied for failure to submit a catch return, payable before the issue of your next permit; nil returns by text continue to be acceptable. We also require catch return summaries to send to the project management for the work on M6 bridges which is starting in 2026. The more accurate and full these can be the better.
5. Membership in 2024. 8 did not renew from 2023 but we welcomed new members giving a total of 72 members and 14 juniors. We continue to attract day visitors.
6. **The new bye-law as passed at 2023 AGM remains in force.** Only barbless treble hooks may be used and all hooks must be barbless after the end of August. Remember the number of fish that can be kept per day is only 1. This is to protect the stock. The bye-laws are on the website.
7. Please encourage friends and relations to join as we presently have no waiting list for 2025.
8. The 'Bring a friend' Scheme continues – see details below.
9. Day/Week Tickets are available (1st April – 30th September) which can also be used to introduce your friends to our waters. These are available at Orton and Tebay Post Office but also via text virtual tickets via the Treasurer – see website.

BRING A FRIEND SCHEME TRIAL

To encourage members to introduce potential new members, this scheme continues for the 2025 season.

Members and Season Ticket holders may use a Bring a Friend Ticket subject to the following conditions.

1. The visitor should have an EA License (A day ticket can be bought from the EA online for £6.60)
2. The member/Season Ticket holder should contact the secretary by email or text requesting a ticket including with the following info.
 - Member/Permit Holders names
 - Visitor Name
 - Visitor Contact details – either email or phone number.
 - Confirmation that EA license held
 - Date of Visit
3. The Secretary or Treasurer will reply with an electronic confirmation (as per day tickets) to both the person applying and the visitor.
4. Visitors must abide by the clubs Byelaws.
5. A catch return should be submitted for the visitor.
6. Only one permit will be issued per member/permit holder per annual season.
7. Bring a friend permits will only be issued **April to June**.

The Committee reserves the right to withdraw this offer at any time.

EXCHANGE PERMITS&ADDITIONAL RODS

The Club has exchange tickets on several quite different rivers. Some of these are downstream and may interest salmon fishermen.
