EXCHANGES : see our website for full details

We have exchanges on the River Nidd with Nidderdale, on the River Eden with Kirkby Stephen and Carlisle, on the River Derwent with Keswick, with Hawes Angling Club and on the Ribble with Ribblesdale and Ribchester.

On the Lune we have 2 paid for Rods at Caton Green and at Burrows Estate and an exchange with Southport Fly Fishers.

On no account must any angler go on these waters without booking.

We operate a 'bring a friend' scheme up till the end of June where a member/permit holder may invite a guest for one day's free fishing. See the website for full details. We also sell day/week tickets via Orton Post Office and electronically by text. We are investigating on-line sales. Please note Tebay PO has now closed.

The **website** is being continually updated with news and pictures.

We have added a new history page with some interesting documents and photos of the river in an earlier time.

We are looking on how to integrate a payment system for day tickets.

The gallery pictures include catches throughout the season – so send in your pictures.

We have been doing work with the Lunes River Trust. This includes volunteering for electro-fishing counts. Our members have also been putting out scotty boxes, preparation of redds in tributary becks and redd counting later in the season with Andy Hurst of Lune & Wyre Fisheries.

Lunes River trust <https://lunerivertrust.org.uk/> is a charity dedicated to conservation, protection, rehabilitation and improvement of the River Lune.

The work by Highways Agency on the motorway bridges is likely to cause issues with access to our fishing. We will keep the website updated as soon as we are aware and are also planning to give some extra guidance on access to parts of the river not normally used.
